Team First Aider

The Team First Aider is responsible for the management of team injuries. Ensure the welfare of all team members at games. The Team First Aider is directly responsible to the Committee and the members of the Box Hill Rugby Club.

Job Description

- Maintain the team first aid kit
- Ensuring all welfare and safety requirements for the team are met
- Attend to injured players
- Provide First Aid advise and support
- Complete the injury form and keep on file
- Liaise with Committee, Coach, Team Manager, players & parents
- Adhere to Box Hill Rugby Club Charter and Code of Conduct

Knowledge and Skills Required

- Must hold a First Aid Certificate or equivalent or club may sponsor attainment of certification
- Can communicate effectively and has good interpersonal skills
- Is positive, enthusiastic and well organised
- Apply for a Working with Children Check at your local post office (where applicable)

Estimated Time Commitment Required

The estimated time commitment required as a Coach of Box Hill Rugby Club is Training night approx. 1-1.5 hours on occasion & Saturday Competition Day of 1.5 hours per week throughout the season.
